Sanitation Collection Schedules and Regulations

Day Collections

Start at 7:00 AM Refuse cannot be put at curb prior to 10:00 P.M. the night before scheduled pick up

Night Collections: Start at 6:00 PM - Refuse cannot be put at curb prior to 5:00

Guidelines

RECEPTACLES: Garbage and rubbish must be placed in standard type container, NOT EXCEEDING 32 GALLONS with handles and a tight fitting cover. THE TOTAL WEIGHT MUST NOT EXCEED 75 LBS. Plastic bags may be used. However, bags must be tied and not overfilled to prevent spillage. All refuse placed for pickup must be accessible to sanitation employees.

BOXES, CRATES AND CARTONS: Must be cut to a length not exceeding four feet long and two feet wide and securely tied. Do not place yard waste or loose garbage in cartons or paper bags.

GLASS: To prevent injury to employees, glass must be placed in solid containers. DO NOT USE PLASTIC BAGS when disposing of glass.

HIGHLY FLAMMABLE OR EXPLOSIVE MATERIALS: Shall not be placed in containers for regular collection, but shall be disposed of as prescribed by the Fire Marshall, (516) 666-5290.

Special Pick Up

You must call for a special pick-up before placing items at the curb. To schedule a pick-up please call the sanitation department at (516) 489 3400 ext. 268

ITEMS FOR SPECIAL PICK-UP BUT NOT LIMITED TO THE FOLLOWING:

Stoves, rugs, washers, dryers, bed springs, tables, chairs, cabinets, doors, windows, air conditioners, heaters, bikes, snow blowers, lawn mowers, sofas refrigerators with doors off, sofa beds tied so they do not open, paint cans...

Items not collected by the Sanitation Dept

Earth, sod, sand, dirt, stone, concrete, construction debris, automobile parts of any nature, materials deemed hazardous, toxic or flammable, 55 gallon drums and oil or fuel tanks.

Yard Debris

Must be placed at the curb on your recycling day for pickup. Yard debris consist of grass clippings, leaves, and shrubs. Tree trimmings, hedge clippings and similar materials must be cut to a length not exceeding four feet long and two feet wide - securely tied bundles. Please keep yard waste separate from garbage.

Thorn Bearing Bushes: Must be tied and wrapped to avoid injury to sanitation employees.

Waste Oil

There will be a large receptacle at the Sanitation Department (470 Milburn Ave.) where you may deposit containers of used motor, transmission and gear oil.
