Village Announces Amnesty for Parking Violations

Village of Hempstead Mayor Wayne J. Hall, Sr. and the Board of Trustees recently announced that the Board unanimously approved an amnesty program for parking tickets.

“In light of the current economic situation, the Village is looking to give residents that may not have the means to pay the full fine a chance to settle the infraction at a reduced cost,” stated Deputy Mayor Henry. “The new program will give residents a chance to pay-off accruing penalties while also generating Village revenue.”

Parking fines and penalties will be reduced by 80% during the amnesty. The program is in effect from February 2 to March 18, 2009.

Residents may pay-off penalties on Monday-Friday anytime between 8:30 AM-4:00 PM at 99 Nichols Court, Hempstead, New York. The office will also be open on Wednesdays from 6:30 PM-9:00 PM.
